Animal Playdough Mats

Engaging Activity for Children: Feed the Animals

A delightful, interactive activity that aids children in developing fine motor skills, creativity, and early language through play.

This printable set comes with five A4 animal playdough mats. Children can follow the prompts on each mat to create food from playdough and “feed” the animals.

For repeated use, simply print the mats and laminate them, or place them in sealed plastic wallets. Children can use playdough, paint, or a whiteboard marker if the mats are laminated.

Ideal for nurseries, classrooms, childminders, playgroups, and home learning.

What's Included:

- Five A4 feed the animal activity mats
- Designed for use with playdough, paint, or whiteboard markers
- Excellent for fostering fine motor skills, imaginative play, and following instructions

How to Use:

1. Print the mats.
2. Laminate or place them inside a sealed plastic wallet.
3. Read the prompt.
4. Create the food using playdough.

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Feed The Dinosaur Pladough Mat

Roll tiny playdough meatballs, leaves, eggs or bones and place them in the dinosaur's mouth.

Adult supervision recommended. Playdough is not for eating.



Feed The Bunny Pladough Mat

Make playdough carrots, lettuce leaves or berries for the hungry bunny.

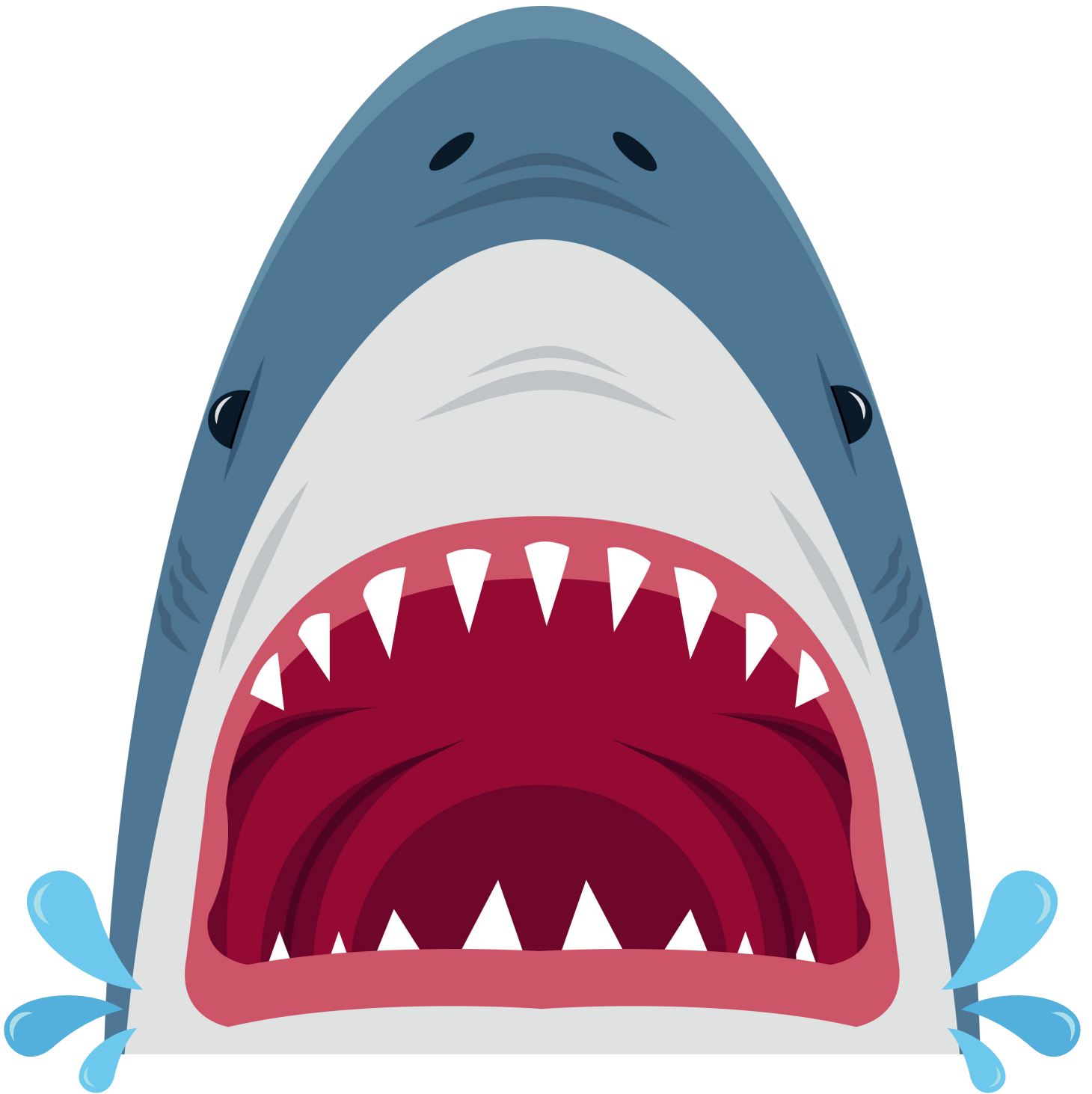
Adult supervision recommended. Playdough is not for eating.



Feed The Shark Pladough Mat

Roll little fish, bubbles or sea snacks and pop them into the shark's mouth.

Adult supervision recommended. Playdough is not for eating.



Feed The Monkey Pladough Mat

Make bananas, coconuts, mangoes or grapes for the cheeky monkey and fill up his basket.

Adult supervision recommended. Playdough is not for eating.



Feed The Penguin Pladough Mat

Shape small fish or snowball snacks and fill up the penguins bowl, as high as you can.

Adult supervision recommended. Playdough is not for eating.
